Bible Study 4 - God's judgement Revelation 6, 8, 9, 11:15-19

John was told: "Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later" (Revelation 1:19NIV)

The 3rd section of the book of Revelation is:

• Future: "What will take place later" (Revelation chapters 4-22) After looking at what will happen in heaven (Revelation 4-5), we now look at events on earth.

PART 1 Background

God's final judgements to eliminate all evil before bringing peace on earth were written on a scroll (Revelation 5:1-5, 9).

About one-third of the gospels focus on the last week of our Lord, the seven days before the crucifixion. 13 of the 22 chapters of Revelation (Chapters 6-19), relate to the coming period of God's judgement before He sets up His kingdom on earth.

1. Where will true Christians be during this time of judgement?

Read Revelation 6, 8 and 9, noting: Six seals (Ch. 6); Seventh seal, which was seven trumpets (Ch. 8-9); Seventh trumpet (Ch. 11:15-19). Note that many things in prophecy are not clear until they take place.
