## Bible Study 8 - Babylon judged - Revelation 17, 18

John was told: "Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later" (Revelation 1:19NIV)

The 3<sup>rd</sup> section of the book of Revelation is:

• Future: "What will take place later" (Revelation chapters 4-22) After looking at what will happen in heaven (Revelation 4-5) after the Christians have been raptured to heaven, we now look at events on earth.

## PART 1 Background

Revelation 6-19 relates to the coming period of God's judgement (called the Tribulation) before He sets up His kingdom on earth. The judgements are given in 7 seals, 7 trumpets and 7 bowls (Revelation 6, 8-9, 1:14-19; 15-16). Now we get more detail of the judgement of Babylon, the Great (Revelation 14:8; 16:19b).

## 2. What did God promise about Babylon?

Isaiah 13, 14:3-27 Isaiah 21:9

Read Revelation 17, 18, noting: the prostitute (17:1-7); the beast (17:8-18); reasons for the judgement (18:1-8); earth laments (18:9-19; heaven rejoices (18:20; 19:1-5); its final doom (18:21-24).
