Bible Study 9 - Christ's kingdom - Revelation 19, 20

John was told: "Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later" (Revelation 1:19NIV)

The 3rd section of the book of Revelation is:

• Future: "What will take place later" (Revelation chapters 4-22) After looking at what will happen in heaven (Revelation 4-5) after the Christians have been raptured to heaven, we now look at events on earth.

PART 1 Background

Revelation 6-19 relates to the coming period of God's judgement (called the Tribulation) before He sets up His kingdom on earth. The judgements are given in 7 seals, 7 trumpets and 7 bowls (Revelation 6, 8-9, 1:14-19; 15-16). Now we get a description of the final period before eternity.

1. It has been said that the second coming is the climax of history. What do you think?

Matthew 24:27-30; Revelation 1:7 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3; 2 Thessalonians 1:6-7

Read Revelation 19, 20, noting: the wedding supper (19:6-10); the second coming (the appearing) (19:11-21); the millennial kingdom (20:1-6); Satan's judgement (20:7-10); unbelievers judgement (20:11-15).
