

Bible Study 2 Transferring to God's Plan – Col 1:21-2:15

God's plan is to transfer sinners like us from the "dominion of darkness" to the "kingdom of the Son He loves (Colossians 1:13-14). But how does His plan affect our lives? (Other Passages: 1 Peter 2:22-25; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21)

READING Read Colossians 1:21-2:15, noting:

Reconciliation (v.21-23)	How had they been reconciled to God?
Paul's ministry (v.24-29)	What new teaching did Paul bring regarding Gentiles?
Paul's prayer: (2:1-5)	What was the purpose of Paul's prayer? <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In v.2• In v.4
Living by faith (2:6-10)	How were they to oppose false teaching?
Why Christ's death is important to us (2:11-15)	What did Christ's death achieve? What difference did Christ's death make to us & our lives?
