- The church in “the ends of the earth” (Acts 9:32 – 28:31) – This study

Apollos (18:18-28)	How are Aquilia & Priscilla an example to us (v.26)?
Preaching in Ephesus (19:1-22)	How did conversion change their lives (v.18-20)?
Riot in Ephesus (19:23-41)	Why were the silversmiths upset (v.23-27)?
