In 444 BC Nehemiah returned from Susa in Babylon to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. The people were allocated to rebuild various sections of the walls and gates. All kinds of people worked together in unity. Their contributions and names were recorded. When they faced external opposition, Nehemiah prayed, posted guards and armed the workforce.
