28% of Americans live alone, while the ratio for other countries is 24% in Australia, 30% in Western Europe and 46% in Sweden. People who live alone may fear having an accident or being struck down by some illness. How long would it before someone found out about it? They may plan to always have a phone on them or a personal alarm to seek help in an emergency. Today we see that when Jesus was arrested all His disciples deserted Him and ran away (Mt. 26:31, 56). This left Him alone to face His accusers during His trial.
