

Bible Study 7 - God's wrath and blessing - 2 Sam. 6:1-23

The context (1 Sam 8 - 2 Sam 5)	Before the reign of Saul, the Philistines captured the ark of the covenant. But wherever it was, the local people were inflicted with tumours. So they sent it back to Israel on a new cart. It stayed at Kirath Jearim for 25 years (during Saul's reign). Saul was the first king over Israel (1052–1010BC). Because of Saul's unfaithfulness, he is to be replaced by David as king. Saul died after being wounded in battle with the Philistines. Then David becomes king of Israel; ruling in Jerusalem.
