## Bible Study 3 - Responding to the call - John 1:35-51

This is election year in USA and Australia. Political drums are already beating. What a contrast with this passage from the Gospel of John. Here Jesus chooses the men who will change the course of world history for over 2,000 years. What a difference!

The context	The gospel of John has a different content to Matthew, Mark and
	Luke. John has no parables, but focuses on the signs of Jesus'
	identity (8 key miracles) and on lengthy theological discourses.
	John begins with a summary of Christ's life on earth (1:1-18).
	Then John the Baptist denies that he is the Messiah (1:19-28)
	and on the next day he says that Jesus Christ is the Jewish
	Messiah (1:29-34). Then it describes Christ's ministry beginning
	with the call of the disciples.
