The Royal Commission into institutional responses to child sexual abuse has affected the church's reputation. Hypocrisy destroys a Christian's witness. A hypocrite is a person who says one thing and does another. The word comes from the Greek word for "actor", a person who pretends to be someone else. The Bible teaches that Christian doctrine (or faith) should influence our behaviour (James 2:18). But what's godly behaviour (v.1-10)? And what's it based on (v.11-14)?

The context	Titus was a Gentile Christian who worked with Paul over a
	period of about 15 years. After Paul's first Roman
	imprisonment, he took Titus to Crete and left him there to help
	the local church. Paul's instructions to Titus are given in this
	letter, written about AD 64. In chapter 1, Titus is told to appoint
	elders in the churches who will refute false teachers.
