## Bible Study 5 – Behaviour towards authority – 1 Peter 2:11-25

How should we relate to the people around us who don't share our Christian faith? Should we be afraid of being infected by their wickedness and separate ourselves from them as much as possible – as some Christian groups have done throughout our history? Should we take an antagonistic attitude toward them? How should we respond if the media slanders the good name of the Christian church, or if Christian people are murdered because of their commitment to Christ? How we behave at work and in society will impact how other people view our God.

The context	The purpose of the book is for "encouraging you and testifying
	that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it" (1 Pt. 5:12).
	The central theme is to stand firm in the faith during suffering
	and persecution. Every chapter refers to suffering. It deals with
	the believer's privileges & duties (1:1-2:10), relationships (2:11-
	4:6), and service & suffering (4:7-5:14). It begins by reminding
	them of their secure future and the need for holiness and love for
	one another. Then because they are holy, believers are to show
	godly behaviour towards authorities, towards their spouse, and
	towards all believers.
