Bible Study 4 – Calling of the first disciples – John 1:35-42

In the late 80s, the band U2 topped the charts with a song that speaks of the uncertainty of the journey and the nature of searching in, "I still haven't found what I'm looking for". The lyrics speak of climbing the highest mountains, running through the fields, scaling city walls, and more, "only to be with you". The song takes us on a journey, while at the same time indicating that there must be something more than the literal path that they are on. Ultimately, satisfaction will not be found in this world. It must come from something else, or perhaps from someone else. We might imagine this is the song of the disciples at the beginning, searching and longing for something they can't seem to find. We will see from their quest that our core purpose might be to seek out a relationship with God.

The context	John was a disciple of Jesus and an eyewitness of Jesus'
	ministry. The purpose of the book is "that you may believe that
	Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you
	may have life in His name" (Jn. 20:31). It deals with Christ's
	public ministry (Ch. 1-12), private ministry (13-17), suffering &
	death (18-19), & victory over death (20-21). John begins with
	the incarnation & deity of Christ. Then there is John's testimony
	& the calling of the first disciples.
