Bible Study 1 – The gift of creation – Psalm 104

There are two creation stories. The Bible tells the Christian creation story – at the beginning of time, God designed & created the laws of nature & the complexity of life. And the General Theory of Evolution is the atheists' creation story. As with the Bible, it begins with creatio ex nihilo (creation from nothing)—and in the atheists' view there really was nothing (and certainly no God) to act as first cause. The big bang, they say, produced the universe all by itself. Then, billions of years later we're told, the first life formed spontaneously in some chemical soup and, without any help, evolved into all the plants and animals found on Earth today—including us.

The context	Psalm 104 begins and ends with "Praise the Lord, my soul". And
	the reason given for praising God is because He is a great
	Creator and Sustainer of everything. God's work is described in
	three time periods: the creation of the universe, which is
	described in Genesis 1-2 (v.2-5); the re-creation of the earth that
	occurred during the global flood that Noah endured (v.6-9); and
	the time since the flood (v.10-32). In Psalm 104 the psalmist
	praises God as the ruler of the world who sustains all life.
