Bible Study 8 - Sin in the church - Acts 4:32 - 5:11

If I want to travel to Western Australia (WA) I need to get approval through G2G PASS. If permitted entry, I must self-quarantine for 14 days and get a COVID-19 test within 48 hours of arrival and on day 12 of quarantine, or at any point when symptoms develop. 	promised (1:4-8) and arrives to live in believers in Ch. 2. Peter	
	gives the first sermon, & the first church begins. Peter heals a	
	lame man and gives the second sermon. Then Peter & John are	
	persecuted by the religious leaders.
