Bible Study 15 - The church in Antioch - Acts 11:19-30

We now begin the next phase of the spread of the gospel (Acts 1:8). So far it has gone to "Jerusalem" (Ch 1-7), "Judea" and Samaria" (8-10). Now it goes to "the ends of the earth" (11-28) including Antioch in Syria, Asia Minor (now Turkey), Greece, and Rome. - Napoleon Bonaparte didn't have a professional army like those before him. Instead, he turned the entire French nation into a military machine. Every citizen was either on the front lines or supporting the front lines. Now we see that every single person in the church is a part of the mission.

The context	Acts describes the spread of Christianity across the Roman
	Empire. The early believers shared their possessions with the
	needy, but Ananias and Sapphira died because they lied to God.
	Despite persecution, the apostles kept preaching the gospel and
	appointed deacons to distribute food. Stephen was martyred
	because of his faith. And an Ethiopian & Saul were converted.
	Then the gospel went to the Gentiles when Cornelius was saved.
