## Bible Study 3 – The believer's inheritance – Ephesians 1:11-14

The Holy Spirit is like a seal and a deposit. A wax seal put on an object or a document was a mark of ownership or identification. It showed who owned the object and what it contained and it carried the authority of the owner. In a transaction the deposit was the down-payment, the first instalment of what was to come which guaranteed that the full payment would be made in due course. When we buy a car we might pay an initial deposit. That reserves what we are buying for us and then we pay the balance when it is owed.

The context	Paul wrote Ephesians from Rome while in prison. Paul was a		
	Jew (1:12) and was writing to Gentile believers (1:13). The		
	temple of Diana was the largest Greek temple in the world. Its		
	worshippers practiced sorcery. The letter begins with praise to		
	God for a believer's spiritual blessings "in Christ". And history		
	is heading towards bringing everything together in unity under		
	the authority of Christ.
