## Bible Study 3 – God's cure: a heavenly paradise– Rev. 21-22

1. Context: Revelation was written by John as a letter to seven churches in Asia Minor (now Turkey) in about AD 95. The letter encourages believers to stand firm against persecution and outlines future events from the Rapture to the eternal state. Chapters 4 to 19 describe the Tribulation and chapters 20 to 22 deal with the period from Christ's second coming to the eternal state. Chapters 21 to 22 describe aspects of the eternal state (God's new creation, a heavenly paradise). It is called "a new heaven and a new earth" where there is no sin or death.
