Bible Study 10 - Paul's farewell message - Part 1 - Acts 20:17-28

Ungodly leaders damage the church and the church's witness. People notice when a celebrity pastor in New York who famously baptized Justin Bieber is caught cheating on his wife. They notice when the pastor of a megachurch in Seattle resigns in disgrace because of a pattern of heavy-handed leadership and emotional abuse toward staff members. They notice when a Chicago pastor who also leads a nationwide network of churches is fired for misappropriating church funds as well as several other notable character issues. Today we look at Paul's parting message to the leaders of the church at Ephesus.

The context	After the Day of Pentecost, the gospel was preached to Jews and
	then to Gentiles. Peter was the main preacher to the Jews & Paul
	was the main preacher to the Gentiles. Paul's first missionary
	journey was to Cyprus and south-eastern Turkey where they
	established churches. Then Paul went on his second missionary
	journey preaching and establishing churches. People converted
	to Christianity and some of the Jews persecuted the believers.
	Then Paul went on his third missionary journey.
